RE: Request for Accommodation (COVID Vaccine Requirement)

The purpose of this letter is to formally request Creed-based accommodation for regarding Western's COVID vaccine requirement (Policy 3.1.1, effective August 22, 2022). As you know, must have in-person access to campus, yet section 1.0 of the Policy excludes students who do not prove receipt of the COVID vaccines. Unless, that is, they have been granted a human rights accommodation.

is unable to receive the COVID vaccines due to Christian religious beliefs. So as to confirm that holds sincere religious beliefs that have a nexus with religion (Christianity), and that would be interfered with in a manner that is more than trivial or insubstantial,¹ for the previous defense of relevant religious beliefs. These are the beliefs will attest to should accommodation be denied and a human rights complaint necessitated.

Christian beliefs regarding the COVID vaccines. Predicably, however disgracefully, **Sector** received an anonymous email denying **Sec** request shortly after submitting it (enclosed). No reasons were provided for the denial, only the conclusion that Western's "position" was that **Sec** did not establish grounds for a Creed-based accommodation. It ought to go without saying that such a flippant, unexplained denial of a *bona fide* request for accommodation pursuant to the *Ontario Human Rights Code* is beneath Western. **Sec** is dismayed that **Sec** deeply-held religious beliefs were discounted with such apparent callousness and that **Sec** has been compelled to retain legal counsel in order to obtain the accommodation **Sec** is lawfully entitled to.

Any assertions on the part of Western that **a second second** religious beliefs are not sincerely held or do not have a nexus with Christianity are disingenuous. **A submits** the fact **a submits** has continued to decline receiving any COVID vaccines over the last year and half, despite intense social shaming and institutional coercion, further demonstrates **a sincerity** and depth of conviction. The specificity of **a submits** appended beliefs plainly establishes the required nexus with a religion (Christianity). Further, any reasonable person, upon reviewing the highly-detailed beliefs **b** herein provides, would conclude that receiving the COVID vaccines would interfere with religious beliefs in a manner that is far more than trivial or insubstantial.

In any event, **and the set of the**

COVID vaccine mandates may assist Western in establishing its *bona fides* as a "woke" institution, but the law cares about whether such discriminatory polices are scientific. Notwithstanding the ideological and optical motivation for Western's COVID vaccine mandates, **box and the scientifically**, both the COVID vaccines themselves and vaccine mandates are unnecessary and ineffective, like so many other undesirable control measures that only serve to abrogate rights and undermine human dignity. If indeed the vaccines are effective, unvaccinated persons pose no concern whatsoever. If the COVID vaccines are ineffective, which real-world data repeatedly demonstrates, then discriminating against, stigmatising, and excluding those who are unable to receive the vaccines due to protected characteristics is not only unlawful, it is nothing short of asinine and cruel. Providing reasonable accommodation to **box and the setting** jeopardizes the "health and safety" of no one on campus.

For all these reasons and more, there is no undue hardship imposed on Western by accommodating students unable to receive the COVID vaccinations due to their sincere religious beliefs. Nor is there any rationale to support a *bona fide* requirement that would see unvaccinated students excluded and discriminated to the extent that they are "dis-enrolled"

submits is entitled at law to be accommodated such that is able to effectively complete all in-person degree requirements, notwithstanding inability to receive the COVID vaccines.

Given the start of classes is only a couple weeks away, **requests** a substantive response to **a** herein request for accommodation no later than August 30, 2022.

Western is in receipt of your request for an exemption from the requirement to be vaccinated, which has been reviewed carefully. The University is mindful and protective of the rights of individuals in the University community to seek exemption from the COVID-19 vaccination requirement on the basis of religious beliefs or creed. We recognize the University's obligation to accommodate persons who, for reasons of religion or creed, do not consider themselves able to be vaccinated.

That exemption depends, however, upon establishing a clear connection between the objection to vaccination and the individual's religious beliefs or practices or an overarching system of belief which can be said to amount to a creed governing the individual's conduct and practices. Western's position is that the documentation submitted does not establish the existence of grounds for an exemption from the requirement to be vaccinated based on creed or religion. Therefore, in order to safeguard the health and safety of Western campus community members and visitors, your request for an exemption from the Policy to permit on-campus attendance is denied.

Should you wish to submit additional information supporting your request and its linkage to your own personal beliefs as aligned with requirements of your religious community, the University will consider that further information carefully.
